EAEU market facilitation

- / Common economic space for free circulation of goods
- / Common regulatory framework and aligned market access rules
- / Harmonisation of import taxes and duties
- / Adjustment of taxes and duties to international agreements (e.g., WTO)
- / Simplification of import formalities
- / Digital transition in customs procedures

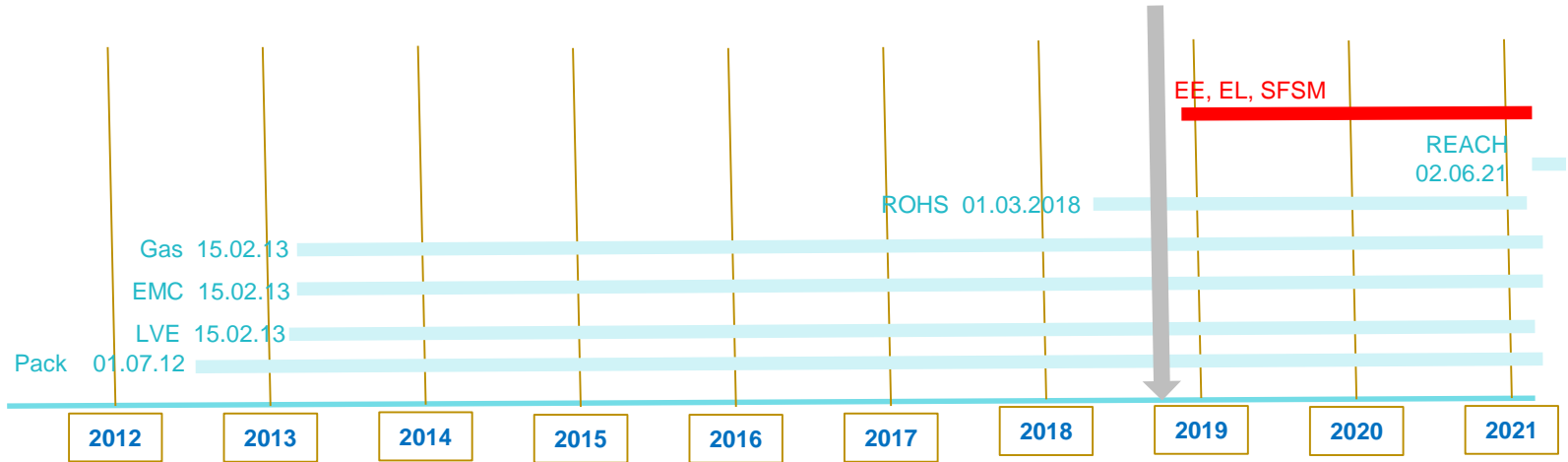

Adopted Technical Regulations

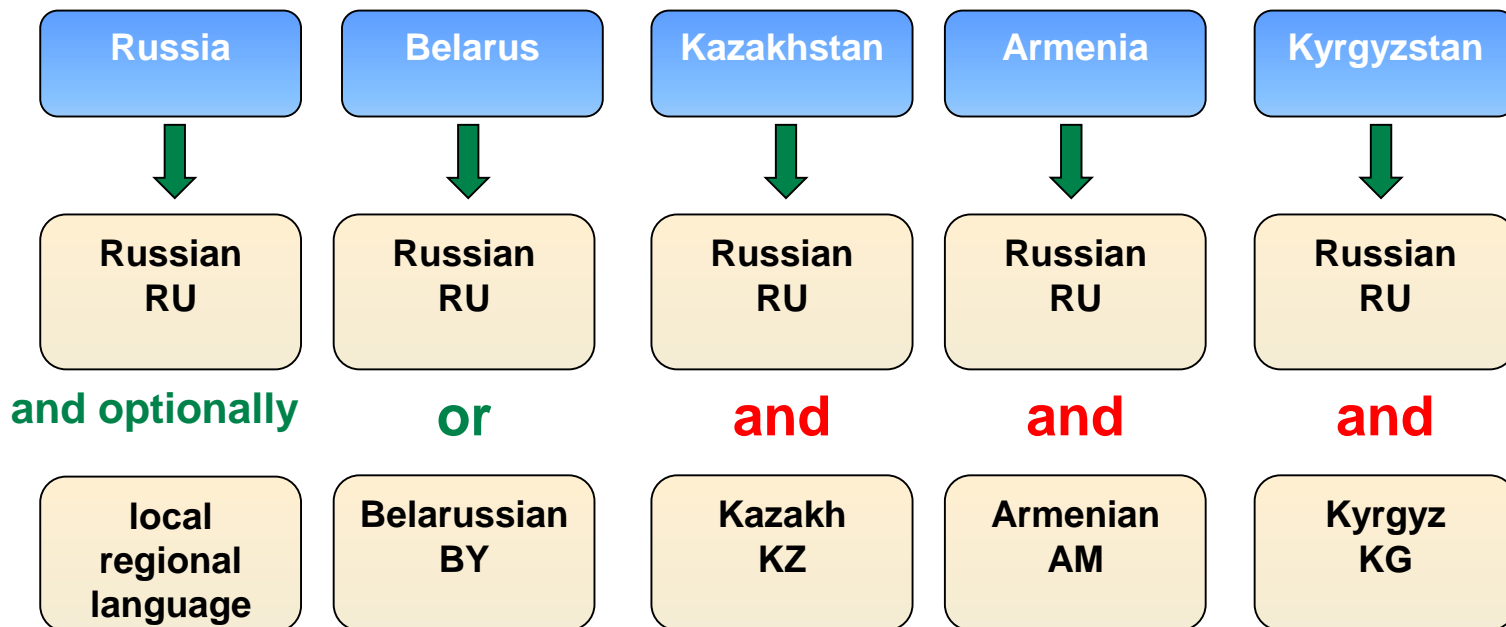
- / EMC TR CU 020/2011 EMC
- / LVE TR CU 004/2011 Low Voltage Equipment Safety
- / Gas TR CU 016/2011 Safety of gaseous fuel driven equipment
- / ROHS TR EAEU 037/2016 ROHS
- / Pack TR CU 005/2011 Packaging safety
- / REACH TR EAEU 041/2017 Chemical substances safety

Regulations in development

- / EE TR EAEU Energy efficiency requirements (Ecodesign)
- / EL Energy labelling regulation
- / SFMS Safety of materials contacting with foodstuff

Specific language requirements

Operational documents must be executed in Russian and national language(s) of the Eurasian Union member state(s) if the relevant requirement is observed by the national legislation of the Eurasian Union member state(s).




Burdens at Customs with documents of conformity

- / Risk of customs' requests for additional documents concerning conformity assessment apart from certificates/declarations/notifications of conformity (such as original test reports, sampling acts, production audit reports, etc.) if the country of origin of the conformity documents differs from the country of the customs clearing the product shipment.
- / The problem has been acknowledged in Russia since 03/2017 as a technical barrier due to the customs e-declaration system's inability to check registered conformity documents automatically online because of different search masks used by national conformity documentation systems.
- / The mechanism is to be unified at the Eurasian Union level to accept documents issued by all accredited agencies within the Customs/Eurasian Union.



Potential of unification of the EAEU regulation

Some member states apply national regulations that can be brought up to the level of the Eurasian Union for unified application:

- / RU Law on energy efficiency N 261-FS of 23.11.2009
 - Introduces energy labelling rules (harmonized to EN05)

 - / RU Law on communication N 126-FS of 07.07.2003
 - Introduces mandatory conformity assessment on comm. equipment

 - / RU Technical regulation on safety of chemical products, Government Resolution of 07.10.16. N 1019
 - not abolished yet, comes into force 1 month after TR EAEU 041/2017

 - / BY President Decree N 278 of 20.07.2016
 - Introduces energy labelling rules (harmonized to EN11)
 - Introduces mandatory energy efficiency certification

 - / BY Technical regulation on safety of communication equipment TR 2018/024/BY
 - Introduces mandatory certification of communication equipment
